Grace raises over \$200,000 for Agriculture Commissioner campaign

Dorman Grace, Republican candidate for Commissioner of Agriculture and Industries, announced today he has raised more than \$200,000 for his campaign since last summer. He has over \$150,000 in his campaign account.

“I’m humbled to have received such an outpouring of support for my campaign,” Grace remarked. “I’m not a politician. I’m a third generation family farmer who’s dedicated to providing a safe, economical and environmentally friendly food supply to consumers,” he stated.

With roots deep in the poultry business, not politics, Grace is a former Director and past President of the Alabama Poultry & Egg Association. The Grace family was named “Alabama Poultry and Egg Association Farm Family of the Year” in 1990 and 2009.

“I’m running for Commissioner of Agriculture and Industries because I’m tired of trillion dollar stimulus bills, excessive regulations and high taxes. Government is out of control. I’m a conservative Republican, not a career politician or government employee. I’ll use my 30 years’ experience as a successful agribusinessman and community leader to bring the right kind of change to Alabama,” said Grace.

Believing farmers are the original environmentalists, Grace incorporates environmental best practices on his own farm leading to multiple conservation awards from the Alabama Wildlife Federation (AWF) and the Alabama Association of Conservation Districts. He was named the AWF’s “Water Conservationist of the Year” in 1999. Through his leadership in the Alabama 4-H Foundation, Grace was involved in the development of the Environmental Science Education Center completed in 2007. He lives on his Walker County farm with his wife and two sons.

Every registered voter in Alabama is eligible to vote for Commissioner of Agriculture and Industries. The primary election is on June 1st and the general election is November 2, 2010. There will be no incumbent on the ballot as the current officeholder is seeking another position.
